(Programs of four hundred fifty (450) or more clock hours or the credit hour equivalent shall administer a basic skills examination to each student who enrolls, unless the student has provided evidence of a high school graduation diploma, general equivalency diploma, or its equivalent.)

Students must be at least (16) sixteen years of age and have proof of education or pass the (TABE) Test of Adult Basic Education with a minimum score of 70% on all sections to enroll at UR Beauty & Barber Academy. Students having a high school diploma or GED do not have to take the (TABE) Test of Adult Basic Education. Students may enroll at any time. The attendance clock hours, assignments, and exam scores will determine completion of the program. Students under the age of (18) eighteen will need consent from a legal guardian.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this program is to teach students the latest nail technology. After completing the necessary clock hours and services, the students will receive the diploma and will be able to enter the workforce as an entry level nail technician.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Nail Technology program provides extensive hands-on experience with many types of acrylic and gel nails. Students will learn to provide manicures and pedicures. There will also be many creative opportunities for students to perform nail are. Other topics to be covered in this program include communication skills, human relations, infection controls, HIV/AIDS, and business ethics.

EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE:

While UR Beauty & Barber Academy cannot guarantee employment for graduates, assistance in finding employment is provided by posting area job openings on a career opportunities bulletin board for students to review. Students also receive training in professionalism and job search skills including how to write a resume, complete an employment application, and prepare for an effective interview. The curriculum places a great deal of emphasis on how to obtain and retain employment after graduation. Graduates are encouraged to maintain contact with the school and follow up with the school on current employment or employment needs. In addition, the school maintains a network of relationships with professionals and employers who provide mentoring to students while they are in school. Job referrals are made known to interested graduates as available.

GRADING PROCEDURES:

Students are regularly given written and practical exams throughout the duration of the program. The minimum passing grade for this program is "C". All academic records are confidential and permanently archived at the school. UR Beauty & Barber Academy grading scales are as follows:

TEACHING METHODS

UR Beauty & Barber Academy utilizes a variety of teaching methods. Coursework from the book is taught through a combination of CIMA Milady's online methods, visual teaching methods, including handouts, chalkboard, and notes; and lecturing on the subject material.
